

Good evening everyone!

The month of August was a busy month for your Horseshoe Bend Deputies as summer is coming to an end. Deputies responded to a total of 190 calls for service this month. These calls included five (5) domestic assaults, several fights in progress, five (5) trespassing, and a total of seven (7) motor vehicle crashes.

Deputies made a total of 20 driving while intoxicated (DWI) arrests.

A Deputy responded to a wooded area where utility workers had located a large quantity of illegal substances (suspected fentanyl pills, powder cocaine, and MDMA). The drugs were seized for destruction as a suspect was not located.

Deputies responded to a local resort for a large, 20 person fight. Initial reports were that one suspect had been stabbed. Upon arrival deputies arrested four (4) subjects on scene. It was determined that no stabbing had occurred. All the subjects on the scene were uncooperative with law enforcement and no one wanted to pursue charges. (1) Subject was arrested for a 12 hour intoxication hold. (3) Subjects were arrested for resisting a stop, detention, or arrest. One subject attempted to flee while in handcuffs but didn't make it very far.

There was a report of four (4) golf carts being stolen at a condo complex. After searching the area two (2) were located within the complex and the other two (2) were located about a half mile from the complex deep in the woods. At this time the suspects have not been identified.

Deputies worked a stabbing at a bar/club in the area. One security officer received minor injuries after being struck in the face with a chair. One victim was transported to the hospital in stable condition with two stab wounds to his neck. This investigation was turned over to our detective bureau and is ongoing. They are actively working on identifying suspects in this case.

One of our deputies attended a Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) refresher training in Jefferson City. The deputy was recertified as a DRE and shared information with our deputies of new drug trends being seen by law enforcement throughout the state and all over the United States.

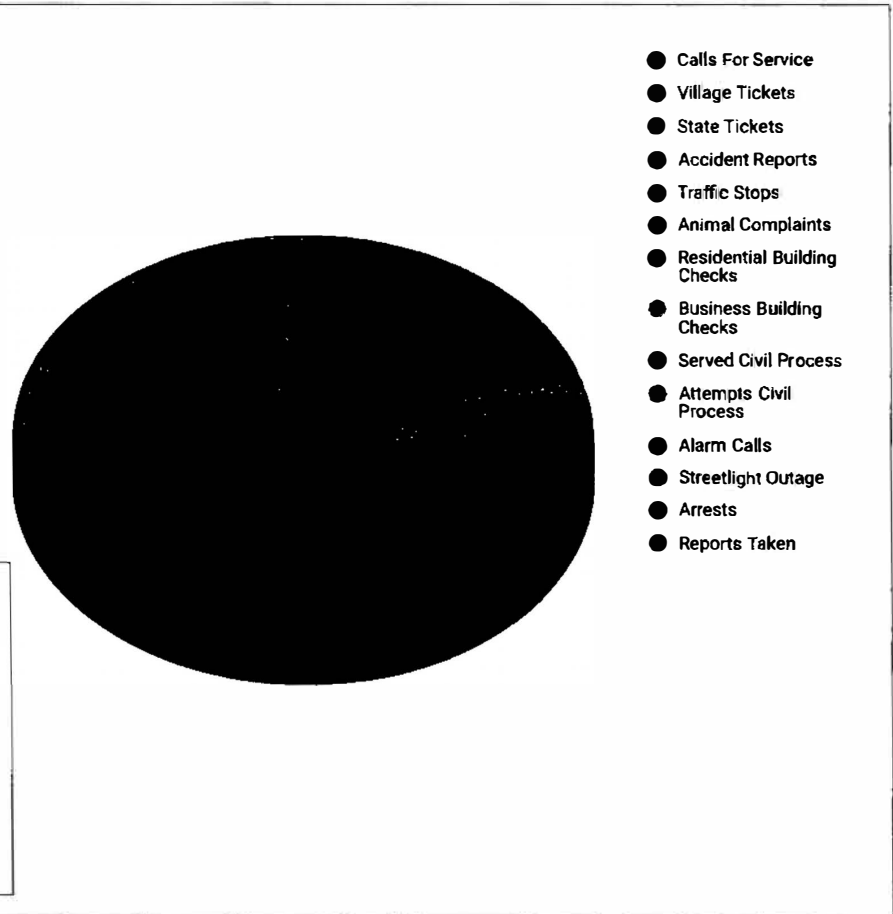
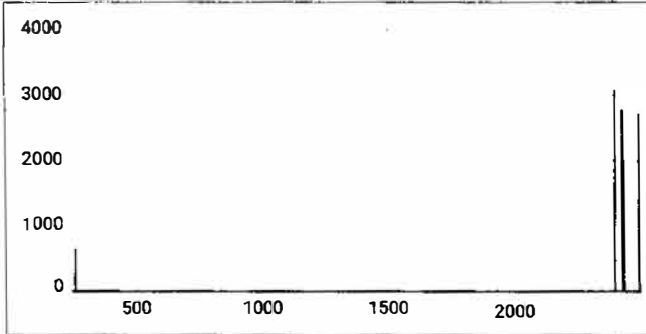
