

Good evening!

The month of November was pretty average for the Horseshoe Bend Zone. Deputies responded to various calls for service including (1) drug overdose, (3) domestics, (4) motor vehicle crashes, (2) emotionally disturbed persons (EDP), (4) stealing calls, (1) property damage, and (1) assault.

Deputies made (2) arrests for possession of a controlled substance and (14) arrests for DWI. Deputies made a total of (22) arrests and issued (40) summons.

One report was taken for a property damage and stalking case. The victim reported someone had slashed the tires on her vehicle. The victim later reported to find a tracking device attached to her vehicle. The deputy investigated the incident, served an investigative subpoena to the tracking manufacturer company to obtain any information they had for the device. He was able to obtain who had purchased the device and who is registered as the monitor. This confirmed the suspect we had developed in this case. Charges are pending in this matter.

Deputies responded to a single vehicle motor vehicle crash on Horseshoe Bend Parkway. Two occupants were located and transported to the hospital. The passenger sustained serious injuries including a broken hip in 5 spots. The driver, a 19-year-old male subject, sustained minor injuries. The driver admitted to smoking marijuana and his blood alcohol content (BAC) was more than twice the legal limit. The driver was arrested for DWI - Serious Physical Injury.

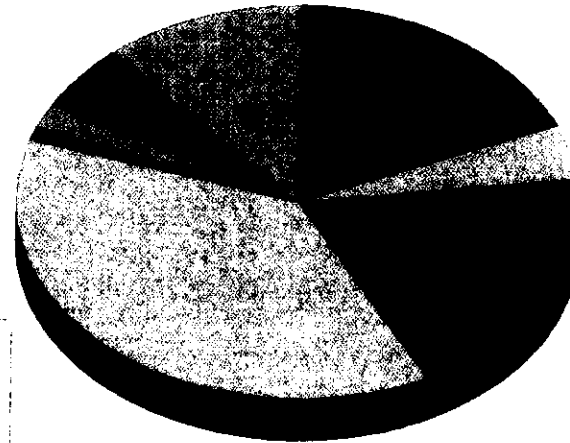
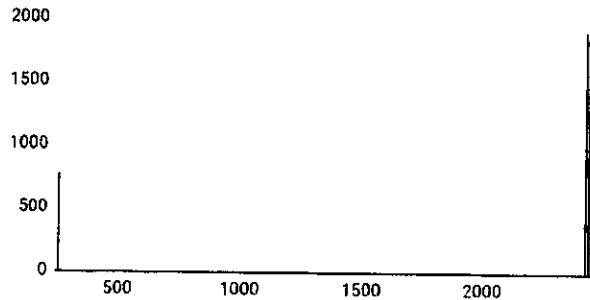
