

Good evening everyone!

The month of July was fairly busy for the Horseshoe Bend zone of the Sheriff's Office. Deputies made a total of 44 arrests and issued 88 citations. Deputies took reports for (1) drug overdose, (1) missing persons, (1) emotionally disturbed person, (3) assaults, (3) drug arrests, (5) motor vehicle crashes, and (6) domestic assaults.

Deputies made a total of (31) driving while intoxicated (DWI) arrests.

One of our Deputies attended training in Norman, Oklahoma. The training was a two day course with a focus on criminal interdiction. This training was hosted by two great training companies, LEO DEN and ACE IT. The training also spoke of mental wellness, officer safety, and how to better recognize criminal activity and further investigations including narcotics investigations.

Deputies arrested a patron at a local bar for attempting to sell ketamine to others. The suspect, from Overland Park Kansas, was found in possession of ketamine and also arrested for groping a woman at the bar.

Deputies responded to a local resort for a suspicious activity call. Deputies investigated further and discovered a 25 year old male subject from the St. Louis area had eaten inside the restaurant. The subject followed a 17 year old female employee out to her car after she got off work. The male subject approached the vehicle, reached inside and unlocked the passenger door. The subject entered the vehicle and asked the 17 year old to kiss and hug him. The male subject also tried to get the female to smoke marijuana with him. She refused all his advances. The subject ordered the female to "drive." The female advised she feared for her safety and felt as if she was not free to leave. The female then drove to another employee parking lot and exited her vehicle with other employees. The male subject fled on foot from the area and was later located and arrested by deputies for kidnapping.

Deputies responded to an assault call. The victim had obvious injuries and reported he was stabbed by another male subject. The injuries consisted of a stab wound completely through the victim's hand. The suspect in the case was located and arrested by the initial responding deputy without incident and was later charged with the Class A Felony of Assault 1st Degree with a \$100,000 bond.

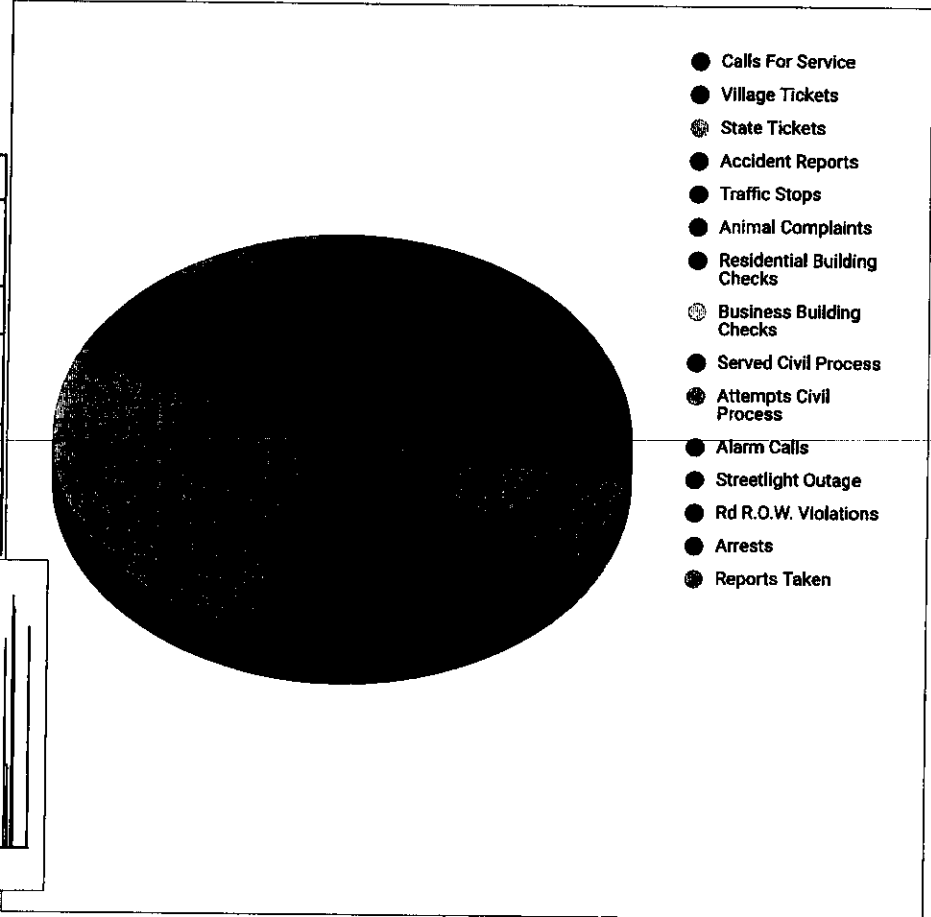
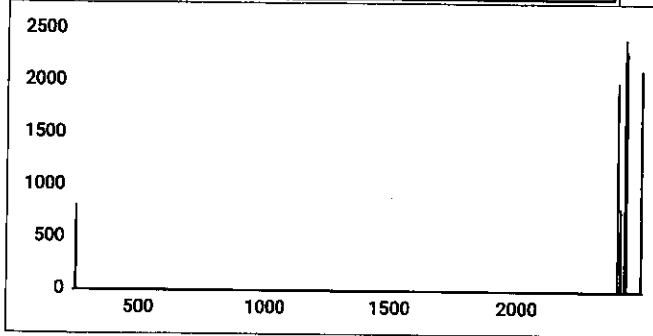
